In her electric fourth collection, Melissa Broder penetrates the itch of existence and explores numberless deaths: the annihilation of self, the bereavement of love, the destruction of fantasy, the transmutation, even, of our ideas of dying. Melissa Broder's collection is a definite departure from the norm of what one finds on the bookshelves of poetry these days. Some poems have "the silent spider" quality of approaching demise, while others explore a sort of sacred space of confessionalism. This is definitely an interesting collection of poetry, though I think Broder could have gone much farther with a less sparse approach.
